- 33.2. The Hearing Biomedical Research Unit has won an award for the way it responds to people with hearing difficulties. An example to us all!
- 33.3. On 28 November, the Government announced the Realising the Value award, all about empowering communities. Voluntary organisations need to attend a meeting in London on 8 December, submit an application by 9 Jan, be interviewed on 20 Jan, start in Feb and complete £500,000 worth of work within 16 months. - 33.5. The Government is consulting on <u>language controls for health care</u> <u>professionals</u> so please contribute by 15/12/14. Proposed standards for congenital heart services are available in Polish, Punjabi, Hindi, Gujarati, Urdu and Tamil here.
- 33.6. Do you have an idea for a research topic? Tell the funders here.

- 33.7. Respond to the government's consultation on autism here by 19/12/14.
- 33.8. Respond to a consultation on **infection control** in the community <u>here</u>.
- 33.9. New guidance on how to use **social media** to involve people in research is available <u>here</u>.

- 33.11. The East Midlands Advocacy Alliance is closing after 20 years work.
- 33.12. The <u>Health Research Authority</u> becomes a Non-Departmental Public Body on 1 January 2015 and will take responsibility from the Department of Health for issuing guidance for research in England, replacing the current Research Governance Framework.
- 33.13. Please respond to the consultation on the **values and standards** for involvement by 5 Jan 2015 here.
- 33.14. Some Derbyshire women have been offered **vouchers** to encourage them to breastfeed their babies, and it worked. Read more here.
- 33.15. The **High Court** has <u>ruled</u> in favour of proper consultation about changes to GP contracts for primary care.
- 33.16. **Publications.** Sign up for the new magazine from the Clinical Research Network here and a new journal on involvement here.
- 33.17. A <u>social prescribing project</u> has reduced Accident and Emergency attendances by 21%, hospital admissions by 9% and outpatient appointments by 29%.
