- 06.1. Can you invite other people to **sign up** to receive *Public Face?*
- 06.2. Lots of events are listed in the **PPI Events Calendar** here. As I go to press, this link has stopped working, but hopefully will be repaired very soon!
- 06.3. Both Research Engaging with Patients and the Public (REPP) groups are meeting in December. Leicestershire, Rutland and Northamptonshire meet from 10am to noon on 3/12/13 at Edith Murphy House, De Montfort University contact Raksha. Nottinghamshire, Derbyshire and Lincolnshire meet from 10.30 to 1.30 on 19/12/13 at Room A07, Institute of Mental Health, University of Nottingham contact Dawn.
- 06.4. Current and former **cancer** patients please attend a meeting on 11/12/13 to discuss a research proposal. It is at Maggie's, Nottingham City Hospital. Coffee at 10am, presentation and discussion from 10.30am, fill in a questionnaire and then enjoy a free lunch at 12 noon. Participants are offered £20 to say thank you. More from Vincent Pang.
- 06.5. **People in Research** run a <u>vacancy board</u> that advertises opportunities for people to get involved in research. You can select East Midlands.
- 06.6. <u>PiiAf</u> is a new framework you can use to assess the **impact of PPI** on research studies. Existing evidence on the impact of PPI is <u>here</u>.
- 06.7. A new website has been launched for stories from people who say research changed my life through getting involved. See it here.

- 06.8. **Invitations** are coming in for PPI reps to get involved, including: the East Midlands CLAHRC has invited PPI reps to carry out a lay assessment of their proposed programme of research; the East Midlands Leadership Academy has invited a PPI rep to join their Board Awayday in January, and the Dementia network (one the Strategic Clinical Networks) has invited a PPI rep to join their second meeting. These vacancies are filled, but please contact <u>me</u> if you want to volunteer or need help finding people to get involved.
- 06.9. The Government's <u>Care Bill</u> will change **social care**. If you live in Nottinghamshire, please comment on their plans <u>here</u> by 20/12/13 or go to your local council to see what they are doing.
- 06.10. Guidance for the **reporting** of Patient and Public Involvement in academic papers (known as <u>GRIPP</u>) was published in 2011. The authors are now seeking consensus on which aspects of PPI are essential to report. They want to hear from researchers, service users, clinicians, funders and commissioners. - 06.11. The Government's <u>Mandate</u> to NHS England has been published.
