- 14.1. This Thursday a group will meet to continue planning training and support for lay assessors patient and public representatives who offer comment on research funding proposals. The meeting is on 18/3/14 from 1.30 to 3.30pm in room A08 at the Institute of Mental Health, Triumph Road, Nottingham. Contact Adele Horobin to book in.
- 14.2. Have you sat on a **staff recruitment** panel that included patient representatives? We will meet to pool our experience of this on 25/3/14 from 2pm to 4pm at the <u>Rosewood Centre</u>, Ollerton, Notts. Book <u>here</u>.
- 14.3. We are looking for someone who can facilitate a patient experience reference group for a research study. It averages four hours a week and involves reading papers, staying in touch, chairing meetings and doing the agenda and minutes. There's a budget to pay the Facilitator. - 14.4. On 11/03/14, parliament voted through **clause 119** of the Care Bill, giving special administrators the power to make changes to neighbouring services while trying to rescue failing NHS trusts. However, they must consult with Healthwatch before taking action.

- 14.10.CQC are to give most **GP practices** two weeks' notice of their inspection visit, instead of just two days. Details <u>here</u>.
