It is our job to check that hospitals are giving good care to people with learning disabilities.

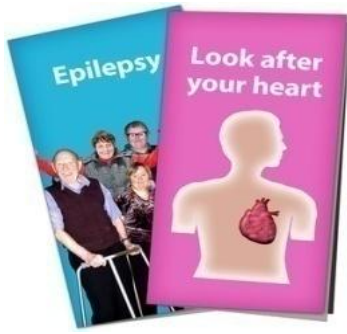
We want to help them to give better care.

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We want to know if doctors and nurses have been trained to give good care to people.

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We want to know if doctors and nurses check the mental and physical health of people with learning disabilities

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We want to know if you help to make decisions when you are in hospital

For example, you might tell staff what you like to eat.



At the end we will write down what we have found in a report.



Our report will say what we have learnt.

It will say how we think a bigger project could be done.



The government will look at our report and decide if they want to give us more money to do a bigger project.



If the Government say yes we will work with many more hospitals all over England and Wales.



We will help them to give better care to people with learning disabilities.
