- 07.4. Are you preparing a bid for submission to a research funder? The East Midlands Research Design Service offers up to £500 to fund your presubmission consultation with patients and the public. - 07.7. Nottinghamshire County Council must cut spending by £154 million. Use the **budget simulator** <u>here</u> to say how you think it should be done. Or Comment <u>here</u> on Nottingham's **city centre** plans by 31/12/13.
- 07.8. **Satisfaction in the NHS**. Resources on the NHS Friends and Family test are collected <a href="here">here</a> and some case studies showing its impact in the East Midlands can be read <a href="here">here</a>.
- 07.9. When a health service gets into **financial difficulties**, <u>Monitor</u> or the Secretary of State can appoint a <u>Trust Special Administrator</u> (TSA) to rapidly sort things out. An <u>amendment</u> to Clause 118 of the <u>Care Bill</u> proposes new rules regarding the TSA's duty to consult. Instead of the usual 12 weeks for consulting with patients and the public about service change, they will be allowed only half this time 40 days.
- 07.10. The Health Research Authority are consulting on their **strategy** for Patient and Public Involvement. Comment <a href="here">here</a> by 31/12/13.
- 07.11.Do you or your relative have **dementia**? In the last year have you/they been admitted to an acute hospital from a care home, or discharged from hospital to a care home? Tell <u>CQC</u> about it <u>here</u> before 31/2/14.
- 07.12.Is your healthcare organisation **ready to hear** and respond to the views of patients and the public? Linda Oostendorp is creating a way to measure this and needs to hear from both patients and staff. <u>Email</u> her if you can help by completing two short surveys (10-15 minutes each).
