- 17.2. <u>Healthwatch Derbyshire</u> is one of 152 Healthwatch organisations created by the Health and Social Care Act 2012 and launched on 1/4/13. It listens to what children and adults have to say about health and social care services and then holds those services to account. Read their recent report <u>here</u> or contact them <u>here</u>. - 17.3. The Law. (1) Since 1 April 2014, patients have had a new legal right to choose the provider of their mental health services at first outpatient appointment, as they do in their physical health care. (2) The government has published new guidance here on when it is OK to restrain someone. (3) A woman with learning difficulties has taken her Council to court for closing Hartley's Day Centre. The Court of Appeal ruled that it was not enough for a public body to consult on the principle of closures, but that specific proposals to close a particular facility would need to be the subject of a consultation with those who used it.
