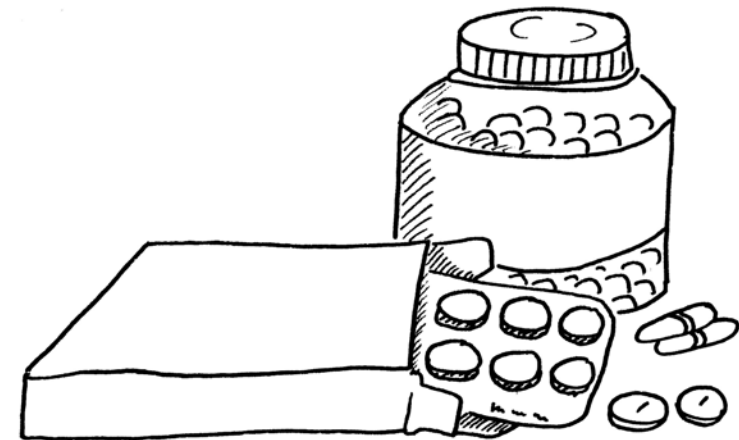


My Doctor is:
